Online Giving: Easy and Convenient

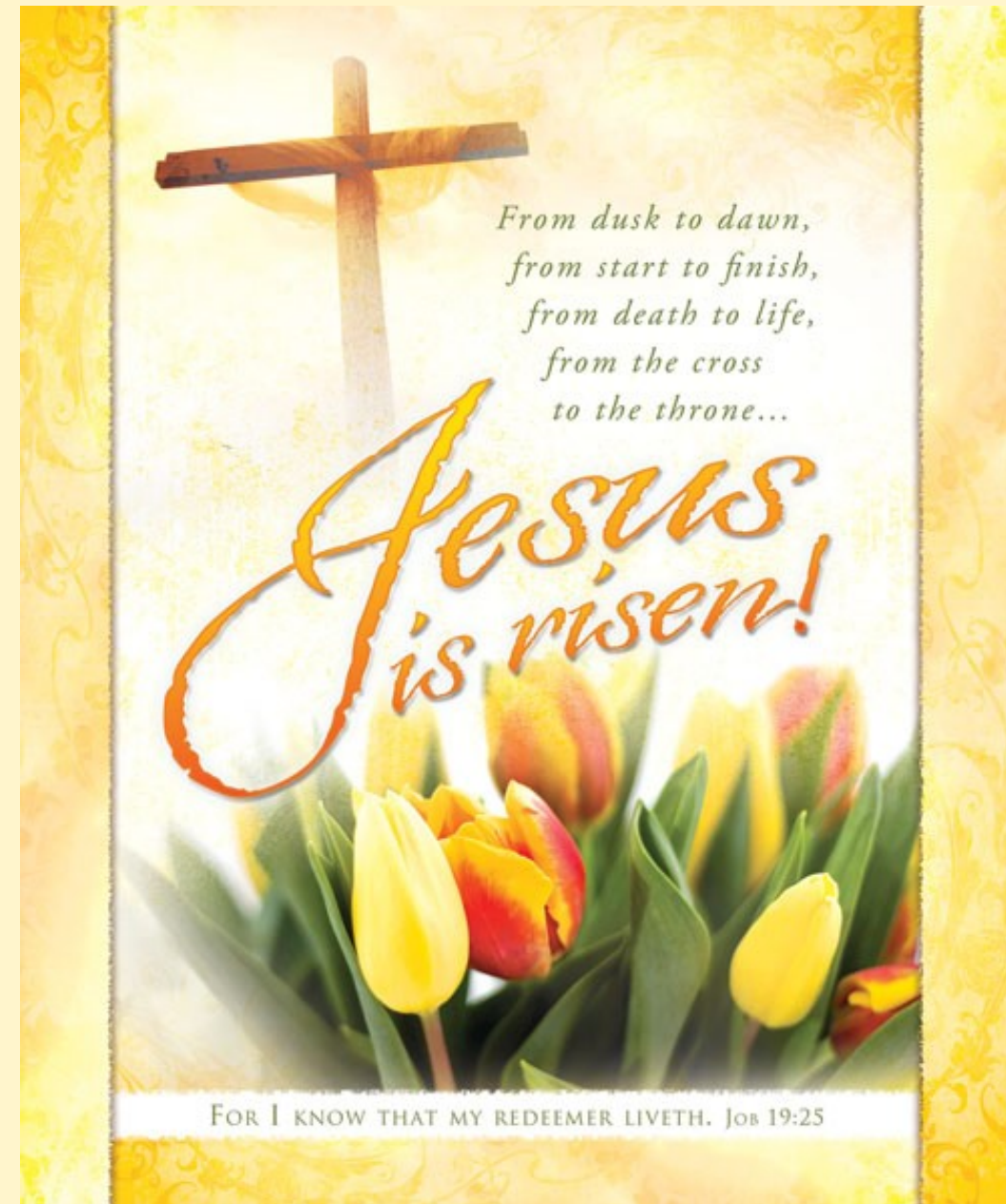
Online giving offers several benefits for you:
